### Gary Corsello as Frank Sinatra

Considered by many as the premiere Frank Sinatra tribute artist, Gary Corsello has performed as 'Old Blue Eyes' across North America and in all the major casinos in Las Vegas for more than 30 years.

Born in New York, Gary has been singing since he was seven years old. His similarity to the legendary Frank Sinatra was remarkable from the very beginning. Gary had a natural style and flair for mannerisms, gestures and the nuances of the Sinatra persona. As his knowledge of Sinatra evolved from a youngster's fascination with the singer to a comprehensive, in-depth knowledge of 'The Man' himself, the two have become inseparable.

Gary began his career in 1974 as a Sinatra performer in Las Vegas at the Four Queens, where he appeared for over a three-year period. He then performed in Florida during 1978 as a Sinatra Tribute artist, and from 1979 to 1981 as a big band singer in New York, New Jersey and Connecticut.

In the 1990's, Gary developed a one-man show, "A Tribute to The Man & His Music" which he performed in New York and various casinos in Vegas. Based on the famous Sinatra anthology album, "The Man & His Music", the show chronicled the life of Sinatra from his early days with the Harry James and Tommy Dorsey bands to his come back tour of 1973. Like the album, the music was augmented by stories and anecdotes told in Sinatra's unique voice and style.

In 2001, famed Las Vegas producer, Jeff Kutash selected Gary to star as the older Sinatra in "The Main Event", the highly successful tribute to Sinatra at the Sands Casino Hotel in Atlantic City. This eighteen-cast member extravaganza ran for eight weeks to rave reviews. Since that time Gary has been performing as Sinatra in various Rat Pack shows and for the past five years has starred in the "Direct from Vegas" version of The Rat Pack, which has toured the United States, Canada, Australia and New Zealand.

In 2005, Gary performed "Luck be a Lady" on a radio and television commercial for Pachinga Hotel and Casino in California. Two years later, the popular commercial is still being aired throughout the West Coast.

Gary's newest project is ARB Productions' *Frank, Liza & Sammy*, a tribute to the 1988 concert tour that saw Frank Sinatra, Liza Minnelli and Sammy Davis Jr. perform together across North America and around the world.
